**Christmas honor cards** for charitable organizations such as The Barnabas Network, Mustard Seed, Greensboro Urban Ministry, Backpack Beginnings, Habitat for Humanity and more are now available at the Sacred Garden Bookstore. **Las Posadas** — This is the seventh Advent that Holy Trinity will embrace the tradition of Las Posadas. Each night of Advent, a doll-sized holy family will travel from parish family to parish family recreating Mary and Joseph's search for a place to stay as they traveled to Bethlehem. The requirements are simple: be willing to open your home to the holy family, care for them for 24 hours, and deliver them to the next household. Mary, Joseph and the donkey travel in a basket with the book *The Night of Las Posadas*, a CD of Christmas music, and a journal to record the holy family's activities. Parents and children can plan and prepare where they will house the holy family, talk about what they might need, and reflect on the meaning of the season of Advent. ### **The Advent Term of Christian Formation classes this Sunday at 10:15 a.m.:**

- **History Behind the Headlines:** We live in an unsettled, complex and rapidly changing world. There continues to be surprising, and sometimes alarming, developments, shifts and challenges to the world we thought we knew. In this class, we will dig down into the historical roots of several of the current "hot spots." *Led by Dr. Jeff Jones, Professor of History at UNCG, Broome Hall*
- **Special Note: this morning,** Dr. Jeff Jones will not be available. During that time the Rector will offer a tour of the newly renovated facilities beginning with Broome Hall. Please join us at 10:15 in Broome Hall.
- **Eclipsing the Empire:** Preeminent New Testament scholars Marcus Borg and John Dominic Crossan travel through Turkey as they trace the Apostle Paul's footsteps throughout the Roman Empire. This 12-session DVD and web-based study explores fresh insights into Paul's message of the Kingdom of God, its challenge to Roman imperial theology, and the apostle's radical relevance for today. *Led by the Rev. Sarah Carver and the Rev. Nathan Finnin, Roe Library*
